

RECOMMENDATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE LIBRARY BOARD

The Library Board is unique among city advisory boards and commissions in that it may make recommendations to the City Council about appointments to the Library Board. Applications to the Library Board have been received from:



Tina Hansen's "Why would you like to serve on this Commission, Board or Committee?" response:

My husband and I purchased our home in November 2010 in Gladstone in order for us to be closer to family (we had spent the last decade living in Washington County for commute purposes), the school district with its exceptionally rated high school and...it appeared that social service elements were being improved, which was extremely important for us. From the family center conversion to the brilliant beacon of hope which was found in a sign on Webster-Oatfield proudly touting, "The site of our new library," as a young family we were lured to Gladstone for these reasons.

My husband grew up next door in Oak Grove & is a graduate of Rex Putnam. His parents still live in his childhood home in Oak Grove. Our in-laws and closest family live in West Linn, Milwaukie and Oregon City and have for over forty years. We are deeply tied to this community and are invested in its future. My husband and I love the fact that Gladstone cannot continue to grow, unlike Beaverton or Hillsboro; however, that doesn't mean that we can afford to toss away the idea of creating a beautiful, functional and affordable library in this great city. I am open to the ideas that may be on the table (I understand that there are restrictions on how the county money can be used, etc.), however, I am a firm believer that a new library must be built and not in the current location in downtown.

My extensive knowledge in real property is the result of almost a decade working for title companies, mortgage servicers and financial institutions – all relating to real estate/real property, contract law, financial and creditor rights. I am not a fan of condemnation of our downtown area (I would prefer a revitalization of the buildings instead). I understand the legal aspects of real property, eminent domain & land valuation due to my experience in mortgage servicing handling eminent domain issues & partial releases, negotiating with city attorneys & government officials at times, reviewing & approving easements and plot line adjustments. I understand & can interpret plat & survey maps, including legal descriptions.

When I was a child, I grew up in a city that had less than 35,000 people in it. In a neighborhood where my grandparents knew who everyone was that lived not only on our street but in a 0.5 – 1.0 mile radius of us. My grandmother would take me to the city library not less than twice a week because I devoured every book that I possibly could wrap my hands around and curl up under our pine tree to read. I loved reading. I LOVED my public library. I loved going through the aisles of books, looking at the covers & titles to determine if I was going to pick it up to inquire further into its imaginary offerings. I learned about my city's history at this library (it was named after a steam engine boat that would trolley through what was our city when it was under water prior to the drainage of the area). I created all of my research papers there; I studied for all of my major exams within its walls. It was my home away from home for the first 16 years of my life.

I have only stepped foot into our Gladstone library three times and each time, it was quite sad. The smell of musty mold infiltrates the nostrils, which is immediately off-putting. The building is in desperate need of more than a studs-out remodel. I want to use my city library. I do not want our library to be built in another community where it is not convenient. Our Gladstone families, as well as all the families of Oak Grove deserve a new library. I would be honored to be able to serve on this committee and assist in ensuring that our community voices are heard and that we can come up with a plan that all not only all can agree on...but can believe in and be proud of.
