## Greetings:

As Executive Director for the Gladstone Urban Renewal Agency, I hereby present to you the FY 2016-17 proposed Urban Renewal Budget for the Gladstone Urban Renewal District.

The proposed budget provides partial funding for projects that were approved by Gladstone voters in November 2014.

City staff has been working on updating the Gladstone Urban Renewal District map in order to determine which projects will currently qualify. This map will also assist with making potential changes to the Gladstone Urban Renewal District boundaries in order to partially fund City Council and voter approved civic building construction.

In order to complete these projects, the Gladstone Urban Renewal District Board of Directors will be required to authorize a combination of Urban renewal, General Fund, and outside funding sources to complete.

The Gladstone Urban Renewal Agency is moving forward in a fiscally responsive, yet effective manner. This budget was developed and is put before you with the taxpayer's dollars and Board priorities in mind. We seek to accomplish the Board directed goals and enrich the Gladstone Urban Renewal District with a responsible and responsive budget.

Beginning fiscal year 2016-17, the proposed City of Gladstone Urban Renewal budget will be changing our basis of accounting from a Cash basis to the Modified Accrual Basis of accounting. This change will represent revenues as recognized when they are measurable and available; and expenditures are measurable when incurred.



## **About the District**


The City of Gladstone Urban Renewal Agency (URA) is a separate entity from the City. The Gladstone City Council serves as the Board of Directors for the URA and is financially accountable for its operations. In accordance with Oregon Budget Law, the URA prepares its own budget, and the Board of Directors approves its annual appropriations.

Urban Renewal Agencies are designed to borrow money and make expenditure for economic and community development projects included in the Urban Renewal Plan.

Urban Renewal Tax Collections are not an additional tax. Urban Renewal Tax Collections are used to initiate development that would not be financially feasible without infrastructure improvements made possible by urban renewal financing.



# CITY OF GLADSTONE URBAN RENEWAL DISTRICT 2016-17 ADOPTED BUDGET RESOURCES




The majority of revenues are from cash carryover which primarily represents unspent restricted tax proceeds for the Civic Center. Collectible taxes have been decreased slightly to reflect the actual amount we have been receiving.

The largest expenditure is the proposed \$4.5 million Transfer to the City Hall Capital Fund.

Because of the uncertainty surrounding the New Library, we anticipate a portion of the funds will be spent to purchase land and begin the planning, and design phase of our New Police Department.

We will not transfer any funds to the City Hall Capital Contruction Fund 011 until we have proper authorization and assurances of approval.

Other major programs budgeted in the current year include a reserve account for continuing construction, engineering and consulting services.
