



**Public Notice**  
**Gladstone Urban Renewal Agency Annual Report**  
**Fiscal Year 2019/2020**

The Gladstone Urban Renewal Agency published the FY 2019/2020 annual report which is on file and available to all interested persons at Gladstone City Hall, 18505 SW Portland Ave. Gladstone, OR 97027, and the city's website at <https://www.ci.gladstone.or.us/finance>. Please note, this is a notice only and not part of the official report.

In FY 2019/2020, the Agency received \$983,240 in revenue from tax increments, plus \$268,614 from grant revenue and interest earnings. Expenditures were \$11,665,845. Estimated tax revenues for FY 2020/2021 are forecasted at \$955,000. The total budget for FY 2020/2021 includes \$3,091,416 in resources and requirements. The estimated impact of carrying out the urban renewal plan on the tax collections for the preceding year for all taxing districts is shown in the table below.
