Thank you for the opportunity to serve your electrical construction needs. Our proposal is based on site visit and information furnished by you. Our proposal includes the following:

1. Install 3 new LED flood lights on existing poles. New light will be higher than existing lights.
2. Install Lexan lenses in new fixtures or install Lexan guards.
3. Install new quadplex wiring between poles to feed lights..
4. Connect lights to photo cell mounted on first pole.
5. Replace conduit on poles for lights and flag light.
6. Replace flag pole light with new LED spot light like at senior center.
7. Replace receptacle on cabinet with metal in use cover.
8. Provide lift to install new lights.

**Subject:** Park Rules

12.12.050 Vehicular traffic. 

No person shall in any park area:

*portion out listed*

- (1) Operate any motor vehicle in violation of the State Motor Vehicle Code and other laws;
- (2) Operate any motor vehicle at a speed in excess of 15 miles per hour unless otherwise designated;
- (3) Park a motor vehicle in any place other than in designated parking areas;
- (4) Operate a motor vehicle—including automobiles, trucks, motorcycles and other motorized vehicles—or bicycle on any area or trail that is not specifically designed for motor vehicle or bicycle use, that is posted as closed to the public, or on which signs have been placed by the city prohibiting the operation of motor vehicles or bicycles;
- (5) Leave any vehicle in any park after hours or overnight without having obtained written permission from the city.
