- Businesses offering investment opportunities
- Fake charities asking for donations
- Scammers posing as family members asking for money for treatment

If you are on the internet DO NOT click on unknown links, visit unknown websites or click on pop-ups. This could cause a virus to be uploaded to your computer or device.
